Step 3: THE ENROLLMENT PROCESS...

- | Once an application form has been accepted and processed the applicant will be contacted.
- | To evaluate an applicant's guitar playing ability a private consultation will be scheduled. Once reserved, a consultation appointment **cannot** be re-scheduled. If the applicant cannot attend this appointment for any reason, an additional re-application fee of **twenty five dollars, (\$25.00)**, will apply to schedule and reserve another appointment date.
- | A review of the enrollment process and studio policies will be an integral part of the consultation. Those accepted into a Creative Guitar Studio program will receive an Enrollment Package.

This audio recording is not used in placement, but to determine coordination, independence, and overall motor skills. An interview process will be used during registration to determine placement into the level best suited to the individuals experience and theoretical knowledge. The quality of the recording is NOT a factor. **The recording must be submitted on an audio cassette or CD.**

Please include the following on your cassette tape or CD:

- Play at least two scales and two arpeggios of your choice.
- Play at least 60 seconds of a rhythm groove in any style and at any tempo.
- Play three songs in any style that best represents your abilities. (Metronome or drum machine not necessary).
- Record your speaking voice with a short narrative telling us why you want to attend and the instructors you most want to spend time with.

After successful completion of this program the student will be evaluated on the basis of; level of proficiency, student participation with assignments, and general academic progress.

Acceptance into a Full-Time or Part-Time Program at Creative Guitar Studio will be confirmed at the third, (3rd), guitar instructional session of the New Student 4-Week Program.

Tuition payments for class dates and times must be organized at this programs fourth and final session to attain permanent active student status. Students who fail to pay their tuition within **3 business days** of the fourth session will not have any future class time held for them.
